Protecting children from abuse

The **sad truth** is that no community in Pennsylvania is ***without child abuse.***

The Mission of Pennsylvania Family Support Alliance is to protect children from abuse and neglect through education, parent support and community outreach.

Affiliate Agencies

By providing programs and training throughout the Commonwealth in partnership with more than 50 child and family service agencies, PFSA works to keep Pennsylvania's children safe from abuse and neglect. We provide educational materials that promote positive parenting, unique parenting curricula and programs that support good parenting practices. These Affiliate Agencies, with the support of PFSA's child welfare experts, bring education and encouragement to more than 6000 families annually.

Parent Support Programs

A series of educational sessions are distinctly designed to meet the needs of families in recovery from substance use disorder (SUD), those incarcerated and even grandparents faced with raising children due to the opioid crisis or other family dynamic.

Mandated Reporter Training

PFSA educates professionals and volunteers to recognize the signs of abuse and neglect and to report their findings to Pennsylvania's Childline. As the designated face-to-face training organization for Mandated Reporters in the state PFSA also provides online Mandated Reporter training and an extensive Train-the-Trainer program enabling agencies and organizations to have their own personal instructor to complete their mandatory training requirements. This year we also are providing Mandatory Training in Spanish. Last year PFSA trained more than 25,000 professionals and volunteers who work with children to learn about their legal responsibilities to keep Pennsylvania's kids safe!

Community Training

The Front Porch Project brings community members together to share their experiences and to learn about child abuse – because everyone has a role to play in preventing child abuse and protecting Pennsylvania's children. Participants learn how to step in and help children in their neighborhoods and in public places when they are concerned about their safety or well-being. Ultimately, their actions prevent children from abuse and neglect!
